

I wanted to follow up and express how thrilled we are with the service you have been offering Cherokee Memorial Park. As you are aware Cherokee Memorial has completed 2 separate projects with California Clean Energy. Each project was easy to navigate, met our needs, and is a huge financial benefit to our company.

As your business is expanding, I would like to share some of my experience with you that can be shared with others, and as I have always mentioned, potential clients are always welcome to reach out to me if they would like to see our system in person.

One of our goals here at Cherokee Memorial was to maximize our monthly cash flow. As we worked with our solar contractor and California Clean Energy it became apparent that we were going to be able to save a significant amount of money each month. The production from the solar that we were purchasing back from CCE was 25% less than the current rate we were paying with PG&E. Once we realized the savings the rest was very easy on our part. The system was priced by our solar installer and then final numbers and cost came to us from CCE. We had our legal counsel review the contract and we proceeded forward. The system cost Cherokee Memorial zero out of pocket and we started seeing the savings right away. Since the solar payment to CCE is the same each month it has made budgeting a breeze for our utilities.

After the system was installed our local installer was setup to monitor the system and if any issues arise they are out to make repairs and ensure maximum production. We were so happy with the first system, we installed another one less than 18 months later. California Clean Energy is great to work with. They are straight forward with their terms and billing. Twice a year they send out a company to clean the panels which is great.



First Congregational Church of Sonoma United Church of Christ

In 2014 our Earth Care Committee researched and developed competitive bid proposals with several solar contractors to install a solar system on our church campus. Two very similarly sized solar system proposals (48 solar panels) were then submitted to us.

The cash-purchase price of either system was approximately \$49,000. While a cash-purchase of the system offered the highest rate of return (about 10% annually), there were other finance options that involved no up-front costs for us, but with a lower rate of return.

To sort out these financing options, it was especially helpful that we were connected to Jeff Ilfeld and California Clean Energy (CCE). Jeff readily volunteered to come to Sonoma to meet with our Committee. He helped us understand how a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) could enable us to (1) contract for the installation of our solar system with no up-front costs; (2) pay CCE a locked-in electricity rate for clean energy during a 12- or 18-year PPA contract; (3) defer all necessary equipment and repairs to keep the system operating, and monitored, to CCE as the owner of the solar system during the PPA contract term; and (4) buy the solar system from CCE any time after 6-years so as to increase our annual budget savings going forward. In the first year our solar system saved our church's utility budget approx. \$1500.

Our committee is unanimous in recommending Jeff Ilfeld and California Clean Energy to you for financing a church solar system. He never hesitated to "go the extra mile," – the "extra call or email," – to help us fully understand the benefits and costs of the various finance options available to nonprofit churches. Not only is Jeff a delightful person, he is most generous with his time, patience and expertise. In short, if your church is considering "going solar" do no miss this opportunity to meet Jeff Ilfeld and California Clean Energy. We strongly recommend Jeff and CCE without any reservations whatsoever!

In March of 2018, the Sonoma Community Center (SCC) entered into a Solar Facility and Power Purchase Agreement with your organization.

SCC had been considering incorporating solar power as a resource to reduce our carbon footprint for the community and reduce costs. The project would not have taken place were it not for the relationship we were able to establish with California Clean Power.

As a non-profit organization we were unable to take advantage of tax credits. The cost of our 87 Kilowatt installation would be prohibitive if we needed to purchase the system. The anticipated increase in electric rates made the Solar Facility and Power Purchase Agreement with California Clean Energy the only logical path forward for SCC.

SolarCraft was our solar system provider and facilitated our relationship with California Clean Energy. Our experience with both organizations has been excellent and we would recommend such a relationship for other non-profit organizations considering a move to solar energy.

Thank you for providing a funding structure for non-profit organizations allowing affordable strategies to achieve energy alternatives and long-term energy cost savings.


